Attention! Battery Manufacturers, Importers, Assemblers, Re-conditioners, Recyclers and Dealers


As per the Batteries (Management and Handling) Rules'2001 and Amended Rules' 2010, it is mandatory to comply with the statutory requirements as per the Rules. In the said rules responsibility has been assigned for Manufacturers, Importers, Assemblers, Re-conditioners, Recyclers and Dealers.

RECYCLERS	Registration with State Pollution Control Board is required.
MANUFACTURERS, IMPORTERS, ASSEMBLERS, RECONDITIONERS	Collect back used Batteries and send only to the registered recyclers. Submit half yearly returns of their sales and buy back to State Board in Form- I latest by 30 th June & 31 st December (For Manufactures, Importers)
DEALERS	Registration is required with State Pollution Control Board and submit in Form – IV to State pollution Control Board. File half yearly returns of the sale of new Batteries and buy back of old Batteries to the manufacturers in Form V by 31 st may & 30 th November every year.
